Re: Notice of Project Initiation

Zoning By-law No. 500 Update – Phase I (Town File: 03.05BS)

In accordance with Section 26(9) of the Planning Act, the Town is undertaking the mandatory exercise of updating Zoning By-law No. 500 to bring it into conformity with the policies, permitted uses and land use designations of the Town's Official Plan. Zoning by-laws regulate the types of permitted land uses and the character, height, location, size and massing of buildings for all lands in the Town. Compliance with the zoning by-law is required in order to receive a building permit for any proposed construction.

The project is currently in Phase I of II. The Phase I study area includes all lands within the rural countryside area of the Town as shown in the Key Map provided on the reverse of this letter. Lands within secondary plans, hamlets and the lakeshore residential areas are not included in the Phase I study area.

You are receiving this letter because of you had requested to be an interested party and receive notification in relation to the Town of Georgina Official Plan Review process which took place between 2013 and 2016.
